



## Hunting Regulation Options for Antlered Deer

### Statewide Options

Please place a check (✓) next to the option you prefer. Only check one statewide option.

- S1. Status quo. (No changes from current regulations.)**  
Current regulations allow for 2 antlered deer to be harvested per day throughout the entire hunting season. An antlered deer is defined as one having one or more antlers at least 5 inches in length.
- S2. Bag limit: 2.**  
Under this option, only 2 antlered deer could be harvested throughout the hunting season. Both deer would have to have one or more antlers at least 5 inches in length.
- S3. Bag limit: 2, one with 3 antler points on one side.**  
Under this option, only 2 antlered deer could be harvested throughout the hunting season. One deer would have to have one or more antlers with at least 3 points. The other deer would have to have one or more antlers at least 5 inches in length.
- S4. Bag limit: 3.**  
Under this option, only 3 antlered deer could be harvested throughout the hunting season. All 3 deer would have to have one or more antlers at least 5 inches in length.
- S5. Bag limit: 3, one with 3 antler points on one side.**  
Under this option, only 3 antlered deer could be harvested throughout the hunting season. One deer would have to have one or more antlers with at least 3 points. The other 2 deer would have to have one or more antlers at least 5 inches in length.

### Local Options

Please place a check (✓) next to one or both of the local options you support.

- L1. Regulated counties.**  
Under this option, the Fish and Wildlife Conservation Commission (FWC) would impose a bag limit of 2 antlered deer per season within specific counties. Both of these deer would have to have one or more antlers with at least 3 points. Counties would be selected for such a regulation based on landowner and hunter preferences. Regulations would remain unchanged in other counties in the state.
- L2. Regulated cooperatives.**  
Under this option, a landowner or group of landowners with at least 2,000 contiguous acres could ask the FWC to establish a bag limit on their land of 2 antlered deer per season, both of which would have to have one or more antlers with at least 3 points.
